

After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and He sat at the right hand of God.

Mark 16:19



There is one festival day this year in the month of May. Ascension Day is on Thursday, May 26. It always falls on the fortieth day after Easter. Many of you will remember that Thursday evening Ascension Day services were regularly scheduled and well attended.

In more recent years the celebration has often been moved to the following Sunday in many congregation.

It is not a festival to be missed because it is filled with meaning for each Christian.

- First of all, the ascended Lord Jesus has gone before us to prepare a place for us in His Father's house. One day we will follow Him there!
- Secondly, He sits at the Heavenly Father's right hand-- the place of honor and power. And there **He prays for us**! At the time of His Ascension He did not leave us, but is with us all wherever we may be in a wonderful new way. He continues to know us by name as our Good Shepherd and continues to keep us in His tender care.
- Thirdly, He invites us to approach the Father in His own Name, so that we can pray with complete confidence that our prayers are heard and answered. At the Father's right hand He serves as Mediator and Great High Priest as He prays for His own and brings the prayers of His own before the Father.
- And the Ascension of Our Lord reminds us to LOOK UP! **Our Lord will be coming again in the way His first disciples saw Him go**-- coming on the clouds. It will be an overwhelmingly awesome day, but we are to rejoice when we see it coming even while others are frozen in fear-- because our redemption is drawing near!

Let's plan to celebrate together on Sunday, May 29. If you can't join us here at church, join us at home with your prayers and praises. The Sunday sermons also continue to be available on YouTube, with the link on our web site.

Treasurer's Report April 2022



Hello members and friends of Immanuel. I hope you have all survived the winter, are continuing well, and are ready for the warmth of spring and upcoming summer.

Finances

With the sudden passing of Bob Brinkman in December before he could complete the transition of Treasurer duties, I have not provided you with reports until I could comfortably understand the details and cash flow as required by the Treasurer's activities and reporting. My focus has been in maintaining a positive cash flow in the checking account and paying our expenses on time.

I am providing a separate report through the end of April 2022, outlining the Fiscal Year July 2021-June 2022 to the present date for your understanding of where we have been financially. I have provided a summary breakdown of Income sources in this report along with total expenses. (page 4 & 5)

Income cash flow breakdown is for you to understand the significance of contribution income to non-contribution income, especially since we have been regularly tapping our PPP grant and our savings, and now our LLF Capital Funds to meet monthly expenses. As part of Other income, we continue to have the Asamblea Apostolica Church use contributions, as well as other miscellaneous income such as Amazon Smile, Thrivent member donations, and flower pass-throughs. Special one-time donations have also helped in covering special expenses.

Expense totals are a simple summary for ease of report reading, but regularly include salaries, IRS and IDOR withholding charges, mortgage payments, utilities, insurance, alarm monitoring, guest musicians, office expenses, and ongoing necessary maintenance, repair, and replacement items. If you desire any details on income or expenses, I will be happy to individually answer any questions and provide a more detailed breakdown by month.

There was a special plate collection after church services in March for Ukraine which resulted in a sum of \$427, which was forwarded in April to the LCMS - Ukraine Special Fund.

Immanuel provided 2021 Contribution Statements to all contributing members for your records and to review how you are performed in achieving your personal contribution goal in 2021. If you did not achieve your goal, please consider bringing your contributions up to date for 2022, or better yet bring them to our weekly Sunday church service. We cannot do the Lord's work as a congregation without your financial support, and we would love to see you and visit with you.




